عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةَ قَالَ: قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ:
" قَالَ اللَّهُ تَعَالَى: ثَلَاثَةٌ أَنَا خَصْمُهُمْ يَوْمَ الْقِيَامَةِ: رَجُلٌ أَعْطَى بِي ثُمَّ عَدَرَ ،
وَرَجُلٌ بَاعَ حُرًّا فَأَكَلَ ثَمَنَهُ، وَرَجُلٌ اسْتَأْجَرَ أَجِيرًا فَاسْتَوْفَى مِنْهُ وَلَمْ يُعْطِهِ أَجْرَهُ"

On the authority of Abu Hurayrah , who said that the
Messenger of Allah (pbuh) said:
*There are three whose adversary I shall be on the Day of
Resurrection: a man who has given his word by Me and has
broken it; a man who has sold a free man and has consumed
the price; and a man who has hired a workman, has exacted
his due in full from him and has not given him his wage.*
