Hadith Zudsi of The Day and Ramadan (5)



عَنْ عُقْبَةَ بْنِ عَامِرٍ، رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ، قَالَ: سَمِعْتُ رَسُولَ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ يَقُولُ:
" يَعْجَبُ رَبُّكَ مِنْ رَاعِي عَنَمٍ، فِي رَأْسِ شَظِيئَةِ الْجَبَلِ، يُؤَدِّنُ بِالصَّلَاةِ وَيُصَلِّي،
فَيَقُولُ اللَّهُ، عَزَّ وَجَلَّ: انظُرُوا إِلَى عَبْدِي هَذَا، يُؤَدِّنُ وَيُقِيمُ الصَّلَاةَ، يَخَافُ مِنِّي،
قَدْ غَفَرْتُ لِعَبْدِي، وَأَدْخَلْتُهُ الْجَنَّةَ".

On the authority of Uqbah ibn Amir, who said:
I heard the messenger of Allah say: Your Lord delights at a shepherd who, on the peak of a mountain crag, gives the call to prayer and prays. Then Allah say: Look at this servant of Mine, he gives the call to prayer and performs the prayers; he is in awe of Me. I have forgiven My servant [his sins] and have admitted him to Paradise.
