



Hadith Zudsi of The Day and Ramadan (8)

عَنْ أَبِي مَسْعُودٍ الْأَنْصَارِيِّ، رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ قَالَ: قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ:
" حُوسِبَ رَجُلٌ مِمَّنْ كَانَ قَبْلَكُمْ، فَلَمْ يُوْجَدْ لَهُ مِنَ الْخَيْرِ شَيْءٌ، إِلَّا أَنَّهُ كَانَ
يُخَالِطُ النَّاسَ، وَكَانَ مُوسِرًا، فَكَانَ يَأْمُرُ غِلْمَانَهُ أَنْ يَتَجَاوَزُوا عَنِ الْمُعْسِرِ، قَالَ
قَالَ اللَّهُ: نَحْنُ أَحَقُّ بِذَلِكَ مِنْكَ، تَجَاوَزُوا عَنْهُ"

On the authority of Abu Mas'ud al-Ansari , who said that the Messenger of Allah said:
*A man from among those who were before you was called to account. Nothing in the
way of good was found for him except that he used to have dealings with people and,
being well-to-do, he would order his servants to let off the man in straitened
circumstances [from repaying his debt]. He (the Prophet pbuh) said that Allah said:
We are worthier than you of that (of being so generous). Let him off.
