عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةً قَالَ: قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ: يَتنزَّلُ رَبُّنَا ، تَبَارَكَ وَتَعَالَى ، كُلَّ لَيْلَةٍ إلى سَمَاءِ الدُّنْيا ، حينَ يَبْقَى تُلُثُ اللَّيْلِ الاخِرُ ، فَيَقُولُ مَنْ يَدْعُونِي فَأَعْفِرُنِي فَأَغْفِرُنِي فَأَغْفِرُلَهُ ؟ فأَسْتَجِيبَ لَه ؟ مَنْ يَسْأَلُنِي فَأُعْطِيَهُ ؟ مَنْ يَسْتَغْفِرُنِي فَأَغْفِرَلَهُ ؟

On the authority of Abu Hurayrah, the Messenger of Allah (pbuh) said: Our Lord (glorified and exalted be He) descends each night to the earth's sky when there remains the final third of the night, and He says: Who is saying a prayer to Me that I may answer it?
