Hadith Qudsi of The Day and Ramadan (27)



عَنْ أَبِي سَعِيدٍ الْخُدْرِيِّ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ عَنِ النَّبِيِّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ قَالَ :
اِحْتَجَّتِ الْجَنَّةُ وَالنَّارُ فَقَالَتِ النَّارُ : فِيَّ الْجَبَّارُونَ وَالْمُتَكَبِّرُونَ وَقَالَتِ الْجَنَّةُ : فِيَّ
ضِعْفَاءُ النَّاسِ وَمَسَاكِينُهُمْ فَقَضَى اللَّهُ بَيْنَهُمَا : إِنَّكَ الْجَنَّةُ رَحْمَتِي أَرْحَمُ بِكَ مَنْ
أَشَاءُ، وَإِنَّكَ النَّارُ عَذَابِي ، أُعَذِّبُ بِكَ مَنْ أَشَاءُ ، وَلِكُلِّيْكُمْ عَلَيَّ مَلُؤُهُا .

On the authority of Abu Sa'id al-Khudri, the Messenger of Allah (pbuh) said: *Paradise and Hell-fire disputed together, and Hell-fire said: In me are the mighty and the haughty. Paradise said: In me are the weak and the poor. So Allah judged between them, [saying]: You are Paradise, My mercy; through you I show mercy to those I wish. And you are Hell-fire, My punishment; through you I punish those I wish, and it is incumbent upon Me that each of you shall have its fill.*
