## Hadith Zudsi of The Day and Ramadan (27)

عَنْ أَي سَعيدِ الْخُدْرِيِّ رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ عَنِ النَّبِيِّ صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَ سَلَّمَ قَالَ : احْتَجَّتِ الْجُنَّةُ والنَّارُ فَقَالَتِ النَّارُ : فِيَّ الْجَبَّارُونَ والمِتْكَبَّرُونَ وَقَالَتِ الْجُنَّةُ : فِيَّ ضَعَفاءُ النَّاسِ ومساكينُهُمْ فَقَضَى اللهُ بَيْنَهُما : إِنَّكِ الْجَنَّةُ رَحْمَتِي أَرْحَمُ بِكِ مَنْ أَشَاءُ، وإنكِ النَّامِ عَذابي ، أُعَذِبُ بِكِ مِن أَشَاءُ ، وَلِكَلَيْكُما عَلَيَّ مِلْؤُها.

On the authority of Abu Sa'id al-Khudri, the Messenger of Allah (pbuh) said: Paradise and Hell-fire disputed together, and Hell-fire said: In me are the mighty and the haughty. Paradise said: In me are the weak and the poor. So Allah judged between them, [saying]: You are Paradise, My mercy; through you I show mercy to those I wish. And you are Hell-fire, My punishment; through you I punish those I wish, and it is incumbent upon Me that each of you shall have its fill.
